1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Nagaland Police Duty-Cum-Sports Meet, 2021 will be held at Chumukedima from 08/11/21 to 19/11/21, however all contingents must report at Chumukedima on 6th November 2021. The Meet will be conducted in accordance with the rules prescribed by the All India Police Sports Control Board. The following instructions are being originated for smooth conduct of the Meet.

- i. **Team Event:** All ranks will be eligible to participate in the team event. The team events will be conducted in the form of 2 (two) Men singles, 1 (one) Men doubles from each unit. The maximum number of players for each team will not be more than 5(five) players.
- ii. **Officers' Category (Inspectors and above only) :-** Medals will be taken into account in the overall unit medal tally. *Officers participating in the Doubles event should be from the same unit.

4. ARRIVAL OF TEAMS:

All contingents must report at Games Village, NAPTC, Chumukedima on 06/11/2021. On arrival the Team Manager shall be held responsible to brief his team to comply with Sports Camp discipline/ Chumukedima Police Complex Security norms.

5. ACCOMMODATION/ MESSING:

All the participants will be accommodated at Games Village, NAPTC Chumukedima w.e.f 06/11/2021 positively (*No teams will be accommodated before 6th November*). All the Team Managers are requested to make their own arrangement for messing. Respective units will bring their own tentage, utensils, sintex and other equipments. On arrival of teams at Chumukedima the Team Managers should contact the Accommodation Committee headed by Shri Aaron Patton, Commandant 1st NAP Bn., Chumukedima (Ph NO 9402022902). All teams will also make their own stall arrangement for Barakhanna on 19/11/2021 at NAPTC Hockey Ground on the allotted site for which team managers are to obtain instruction from Convener, Accommodation Committee on arrival.

7. UNIFORM AND FLAGS FOR MARCH PAST :

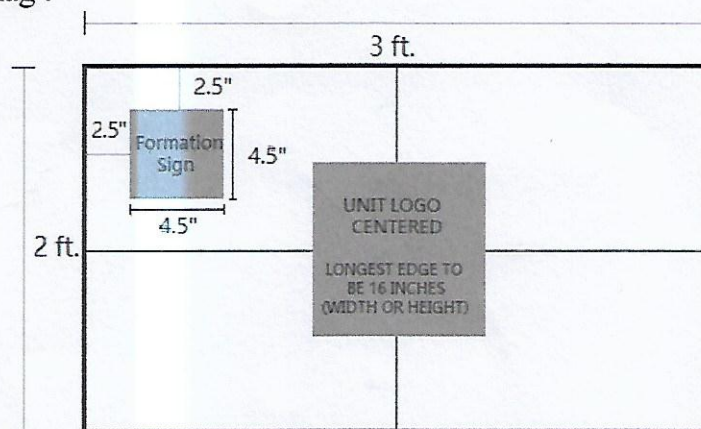
All members of each team should don identical attire, be it track suit, vest, blazer etc. Each teams should also bring 2 (two) flags of the Unit of the following dimensions:

- i) To be hoisted at NAPTC Stadium - 6' x 4' - 1 no.
- ii) For the March Past - 3' x 2' - 1 no.

UNIT FLAG –

- i) All unit flags should be as per the colour allotted to the units. Units who have been allotted dual colours shall place the colours in a HORIZONTAL position with a middle parting in the flag with equal dimension. Colours not to be used vertically, diagonally or in any other shape or size.
- ii) All unit flag shall have their respective unit logo, motto, unit name imprinted, drawn or embroidered in the centre of the flag. (Size of the unit logo should be: Breadth – 12 in. minimum – 16 in. maximum; Height - 12 in. minimum – 16 in. maximum for 3 ft. x 2 ft. flag. The size will be doubled for 6 ft. x 4 ft. flag)
- iii) All unit flag shall have Nagaland Police Formation Sign imprinted, drawn or embroidered on the upper left hand corner of the flag. The position of the Formation Sign should be 2.5 inches from the upper and left edges of the flag. (Size of Nagaland Police Formation Sign should be: Breadth – 4.5 inches; Height - 4.5 inches. The size will be doubled for 6 ft. x 4 ft. flag)

11. POINTS & MEDAL SYSTEM:

All the games will be conducted on league-cum-knock-out basis.

In a league match no team is allowed to forfeit without playing or without completing the match. If a team forfeits without starting the game or after few minutes (before the match is completed), the concerned team's points in all previous matches will be forfeited.

II. Team Ranking :

The Overall Champion for NPM 2021 shall be based on the Gold Medal Method. The unit with the highest number of Gold Medals shall be declared the Overall Champion. In the event two or more units end up with the same number of gold medals, the unit with the highest silver medals shall be declared the Champion. In the event two or more units end up with the same numbers of gold medals and silver medals, the unit with the most number of bronze medals shall be declared the Champion. In event two or more units end up with the same number of gold medals, silver medals and bronze medals, they will be declared joint Champions.

12. WEAPONS HANDLING:

Weapons Handling Competition will be compulsory for all units irrespective of DEFs, NAP and IR Bns. The competition will be held in 4(four) categories:

The team should consist of 1(one) participant for each weapon plus 2(two) persons as standby for a total of 6(six) persons in a team. Dress order will be FSMO 'B' Scale.

13. BARAKHANA:

Barakhana will be held on 19th November 2021. All Units are to prepare their own food and assemble at the earmarked place for the Barakhana. A Central Mess will be arranged for Guests, Invitees, Team Managers and GO's.

ii) Security :

All participating teams shall bring individual identity cards and shall abide by the security norms and rules of the Chumukedima Police Complex during the meet.

- Unit commanders are impressed upon to depute a responsible Team Manager having good command and control over the men. The Team manager will be held personally responsible for any breach of discipline by his/her team members. Any breach of discipline will not be tolerated under any circumstances and very strict action will be taken.**
